Have you seen the forecast for Sailstice weekend? It's mostly sunny from Friday afternoon right through to Monday afternoon. BEAUTIFUL!

Join members of HSA1 and NSHSA on June 20 on the Corsica. Nine boats have already registered at <https://summersailstice.com/event/hunter-chesapeake-sailstice-celebration>.

We expect to have more than a dozen. Registration isn't mandatory, but it makes you eligible for some of the nice prizes.

We will not have a centralized raft. Some boats will choose to anchor alone. I encourage anyone who rafts to limit the number of people on the raft.

Visit by dinghy to maintain social distancing. Don't have a dinghy? No worries. Enough members have them that you can get visitors tied to the back of your transom. I discourage sharing snacks.

If you have a musical instrument and would like to serenade the anchorage at dusk, please do. It would be a peaceful replacement for the revelry of our usual raft-ups.

Our Corsica River anchorage is beyond the "4" daymark and between Walsh Point and Rocky Point; coordinates N 39° 4.8', W 076° 6.5'. It's there because the beach at Rocky Point is reported as the best place along the River to take a dog ashore.
